With only \$10 to file an LLC, Creative Hair School of Cosmetology opens October 1, 1999 on Clio Road in Flint, Michigan.

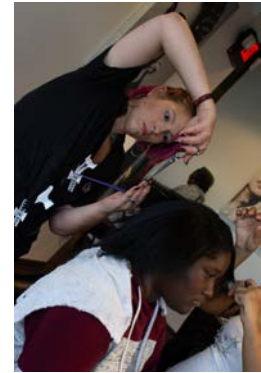


JANUARY 2016




Creative Hair School of Cosmetology is currently the only accredited cosmetology school in the State of Michigan that offers a Natural Hair Program.
